TYRE TALK - IN STOCK NOW ARE THE Mitas 21inch trials front tyre. The radial tyres many of us have fitted to twinshocks slip off the bead when using low pressures for trials. The Mitas are new 4 ply tires with stronger sidewalls for old rim widths - no slipping off bead. Modern trials radial tyres have been designed to fit the wider rim width for modern trials bikes.
